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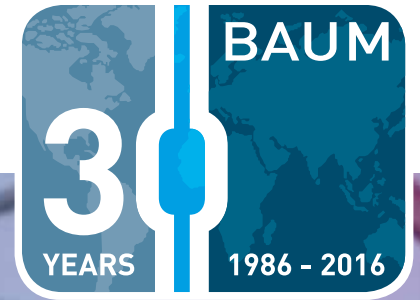
Dear Readers,

Our subsidiary in Shanghai

With an area of 912 square meters and a production output of thousands of parts per year, BAUM Fluorplastic is one of our most important and fastest growing foreign subsidiaries. There, we mainly manufacture PTFE-lined pipes and molded parts for well-known customers such as BASF, Bayer, LONZA and Wacker.

BAUM established a local presence in China in 2006 in what would prove to be a very smart strategic move. The proximity to customers based in the region means that transport routes are

kept particularly short and production is highly flexible. Warehouses for prefabricated ANSI and DIN parts and injection molded PFA parts made in Germany allow quick access and expand our on-site product portfolio. The result is the ideal supply of our local customers with what they need, even for large-scale projects. In 2013, BAUM delivered 12 million Chinese yuan worth of products to the new MDI production site of chemical giant BASF in Chongqing, proving yet again how effortlessly our company handles large order volumes.
